B Fees For Repeating Students Part time (within the Faculty of HE)

The amount is based on the course fees and the amount of credits

Eg: £9000/120 credit = £75 per credit
Resit for 15 credits will be $15 * £75 = £1125$

Student repeating the year or returning from a period of intermission will pay the same fees as they did in the academic year they started. This will also apply to the HE courses residing outside the department of Higher Education.

C Hardship Fund for Home and EU students studying on HE courses

The College will make available to all students access to apply to a hardship fund, details of which will be published on the College website. Any student wanting to claim the hardship fund must contact the HE support team to check if they meet the necessary criteria.

Disclaimer

This information tries to answer your questions relating to tuition fees and funding. The bursaries will be subject to the annual inflationary increases announced by the Government (assuming the variable fee also increases in line with the annual inflation rate). Means tested thresholds will also increase in line with any Government announcements.

UK students - for all residual household income categories, the College bursary will be in addition to the assistance available from the Student Finance England. If students are eligible they may receive multiple bursaries/fee waivers. These Bursaries will require a student loan application even if no tuition fee support is required for further information please contact Finance Team on 01702 220428 or email hefinance@southessex.ac.uk.

Please note: **EU students** are not eligible for the UK Government maintenance grant or the College Bursary. EU students should contact the Government in their own country to see if they are eligible for any financial support from them.

D Payment Methods

Home and EU students studying full time or studying 60 credits or more part time; Self Payers and students whose fees are paid by their employer

Fees may be paid in full at enrolment, payment may be made by cheque, cash, debit or credit card.

Alternatively, fees may be paid in three instalments:

1st instalment payment 25%

2nd instalment payment 25%

3rd instalment payment 50%

Installment dates to be confirmed.

International Students:

International students are required to pay full deposit of tuition fees for one academic year or for remaining course period (whichever is shorter) before any Unconditional Offer/CAS is issued, or enrolment is taken.

Students studying full time and applying for the Tuition Fee Loan (Home Students only)

Students **must** provide evidence of their application and/or approval for the tuition fee loan at enrolment. Suitable evidence is the Student Finance England Support Number or confirmation sheet of tuition fees to be paid to the College. If evidence of application to Student Finance England for the student tuition loan cannot be provided at enrolment, self-paying status will be applied and students will be subject to the payment details stated above. However this may be overturned by providing Student Finance England confirmation of tuition fee support to our finance team at hefinance@southessex.ac.uk prior to Wednesday 20th October 2021.

Home students studying less than 60 credits part time

Tuition fees are payable in full at enrolment. Students must enrol by **TBC** for all modules.

Students repeating modules without attendance

Tuition fees are payable in full at enrolment. Students must enrol by **TBC** for all modules.

International/EU Students

The amount is based on the course fees and the amount of credits that need to be retaken

e.g.: £17,930/120 credit = £149.41 per credit
Resit for 15 credits will be 15*£149.41 = £2241.25

Late Payment Fees

All payments made after the stated deadlines will incur a late payment fee of £25.

E Notes

Tuition Fee Funding Eligibility

Generally, you will only receive student finance if you are undertaking your **first** higher education qualification. However, you may still receive it if, for example:

- you change course
- you leave your course but decide to start again
- you are 'topping up' a higher education qualification, e.g. you've finished an HNC, HND or foundation degree and now want to study an Honours degree

Withdrawal or intermission from a programme of study

The College recognises that some students are not able to continue their studies and seeks to support them during the process of withdrawal or intermission. Therefore, the following fees will apply:

Students who withdraw or intermit after Monday 11 th October 2021 and before Thursday 16 th December 2021	25% of fees payable
Students who withdraw or intermit after Monday 3 rd January 2022 and before Friday 1 st April 2022	50% of fees payable
Students who withdraw after Monday 4 th April 2022	100% of fees payable

International Student Fee Status

Tuition deposits are NOT refundable unless a student visa is rejected. In such case, the College will refund the received tuition deposit less 5% of the annual tuition fees or £200 (Whichever is greater) as administration fees upon the receipt of original visa refusal letter.
